# 2016 John Q. Sherman Award for Excellence in Patient Engagement Rules and Regulations

## **Eligible Participants**

The award is intended for healthcare provider institutions, organizations and individuals (including providers, patients and families) who are directly involved in the care setting. Self-nominations will be accepted. It is not open to businesses that provide products, services or solutions to healthcare providers.

# **Eligibility Timeframe**

Work must have occurred between January 1, 2014 and January 31, 2016.

All nominations for the 2016 John Q. Sherman Award must be submitted on the Official Nomination Form for 2016 which is available online. It includes:

Completed nominations must be submitted online. Deadline is Friday, March 11, 2016.

By submitting the nomination, you give the award organizers the right to publish your name and submitted content to the EngagningPatients.org website.

You also agree that all content submitted is original and yours to submit. All nominations are subject to verification by the Nomination Committee. Accepted nominations may be asked to supply additional supporting materials by the Nomination Committee.

## Winner Notification

The winner will be notified the week of **April 18**, **2016** and is asked to keep the award confidential until time of award presentation, except for supervisors and those who have an immediate need to know within the winner's organization.

### **Award Presentation**

The award will be conferred on **May 24, 2016** at NPSF's National Patient Safety Congress in Scottsdale, Arizona. The recipient must arrange to be present.

Registration expenses to full conference, including all-day pre-Congress session, will be covered by award organizers. Travel expenses will be covered for the individual award recipient or one representative of the winning team or institution. Travel expenses include round-trip domestic coach air travel to Scottsdale, three nights hotel and airport transfers.
